Nunawading Market Traffic Management Plan

The City of Whitehorse requires us to have a market traffic management plan for the safety of stall-holders and the general public.

Stall-holders: please follow the regulations set out below.

1. Public Parking

The car park on the Police Station side of the Civic Centre is for customers only.

2. Speed Limit

10 kph. Drive slowly & carefully and watch out for pedestrians.

3. Traffic flow

The general traffic flow direction is from Traffic Lights entrance to exit near Police Station.

- 4. Stall-holders who have approval to park behind their stall on sites opposite and west of the Willis Room (sites 1-5 & sites 46-52): enter and exit the market via the traffic lights entrance. Do not park on a vacant site.
- 5. Stall-holders who have approval to park behind their stall on other sites: enter the market via the traffic lights entrance and exit via the driveway near the Police Station. Do not park on a vacant site.
- **6. Stall-holders without approval to park on their site:** enter the market via the traffic lights entrance, unload your goods, exit via the driveway near the Police Station and drive round to the traffic lights entrance and park in the area at the rear of the Civic Centre where there is ample day-long space.

After closing time: drive carefully into the market from the traffic lights end, load your vehicle and drive out via the driveway near the Police Station.

- 7. **Do not** drive into or out of the market after 8.45am and before 2.15pm closing time. (12.45pm and 5.15pm at the Christmas Market.) The entrance and exit will be blocked off during these times.
- 8. To ensure emergency service vehicles have easy access to the Civic Centre building and stall sites, do not double park or exceed the allocated stall space.
- **9**. Please be mindful of other Stall-holders when unloading vehicles please do not stop on another Stall-holder's site or on/near pedestrian walk ways.
- 10. Any Stall-holder-holder or Stall-holders helper who does not comply with our parking regulations may be removed from the Market and any fees paid in advance can be forfeited.
